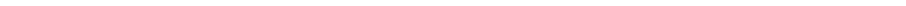




Use the numberline to solve each problem.

Answers

1) $35 \div 7 = 0$

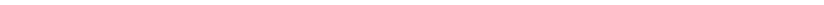

2) $21 \div 7 = 0$

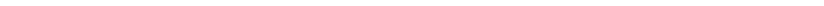

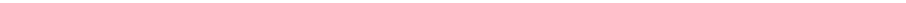

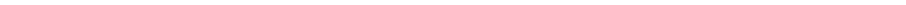

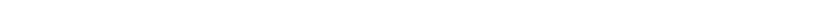

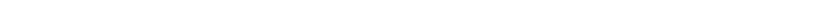

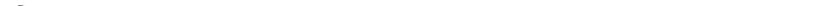
